MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING – 1 PM

PRESENT VIA TELEPHONE: Chairman Clay Wagner, Commissioners Bill F. Cossar, Scott Coopwood, Robert Taylor, and Billy Mounger, attended the meeting via telephone.

Noted for the Record: Attached to these minutes are copies of the Special Teleconference Meeting Notices, which were posted one day prior to the meeting on the doors of the MDWFP office building located at 1505 Eastover Drive, Jackson, MS, and on the MDWFP website and the Mississippi Open Meetings website, as per the provisions of the Mississippi Open Meetings Act.

Having determined that a quorum was present, the Chairman opened the floor to the business on the agenda.

The Executive Director requested the Special Meeting of the Commission to continue discussion on Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD) and Harvest Reporting. Staff presented ideas for proposed rule changes and proposed changes to statutes which would require legislative action. The proposed rule changes and statutory changes were developed pursuant to the wishes of the Commission expressed at the previous month's educational session.

Discussion followed. Generally, the Commission expressed approval of the proposed statutory changes; however, the consensus was that the proposed rule changes were confusing. That being said, staff proposed a comprehensive re-write of the current rules regarding high-fenced enclosures and CWD response, as opposed to an amendment of the current rules. The Commission agreed.

The proposed Harvest Reporting bill is the same as passed the House of Representatives last year. Tagging is expressly prohibited in the bill and all that is authorized is online or other electronic reporting of basic harvest data. The Commission found the proposed bill acceptable.

No vote or action was required or taken on any of the discussed items.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business before the Commission, Commissioner Taylor made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Commissioner Cossar, and the motion carried.

Chairman Wagner gaveled the meeting into adjournment.


