


How to Board a Beaver to the Proper Size




Fold the beaver pelt lengthwise on the board. Center the pelt within the size rings and pull out.




Begin with four nails. One at the nose, one at the tail, and one on each flank.




Add nails in between the others. At this point, if you have difficulty stretching the pelt and securing the nails, you might want to consider dropping down half a size.



Release the pelt and allow it to return to its natural lenght, then choose the correct sizing line.



Add another four nails, one near each leg.



Finish nailing the rest of the pelt using at gap of one inch. It should be taut but not tight
